This book sets out to test the hypothesis that the fundamental concept which determines the validity and competence of usurper regimes in common law jurisdictions is the concept of legitimacy as was clearly elucidated in the Grenada Case of Mitchell v DPP (1986). A comparative analysis of this case in juxtaposition with sixteen other extraconstitutional common law cases comprised the main scope of the study. Consequently, an exhaustive survey of these cases beginning with the Dosso case in Pakistan in 1958 and ending with the Qarase case in Fiji in 2009 was conducted. The analysis reveals that the appropriateness of utilizing any of the judicially recognized doctrinal concepts of strict constitutionalism, state necessity, Kelsen's theory of revolutionary legality and the doctrine of successful revolution depends, inter alia, on whether there was continuity or discontinuity of the legal order of the state. These doctrinal concepts have their own implications for the concept of legitimacy following the occurrence of a coup d'etat or a revolution. Legitimacy itself has important implications for resolving various extra-constitutional issues which inevitably arise.

Dr. Lawrence Albert Joseph was born in Grenada, In 1977 he became qualified as a Barrister at Law, Lincoln's Inn, London, England. On his return to Grenada, Dr. Joseph became a magistrate (1979-84), President of the Senate (1984-88) and 2013-14), Attorney General amongst other ministerial port folios (1995-2003) and Speaker of the House of Representatives (2003-08).

In the Queen's New Year Honours of 2015, Dr. Joseph was granted the award of Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of the British Empire (CBE) for his contributions to public service in Grenada. At the 2016 Independence Celebrations on 7th February in Grenada, he was awarded the Most Distinguished Order of the Nation for 2015, Knight Commander (KCN) for his contributions to Grenada.
