The Law of Rights of Light is a new and comprehensive treatment of the controversial topic of rights of light. It considers how rights can be established, what constitutes an infringement of those rights and what remedies can be provided for the infringement of those rights. It explains how claims may be defended and rights overridden. By setting the law in its wider context, the book seeks to show that, despite the technicalities which arise, there are no legal problems with which a competent lawyer cannot grapple.

The book benefits from two technical appendices and colour illustrations provided by *Point 2 Surveyors*. The first explains how light is measured; the second how losses are valued. These appendices also explain the limits of current methodology. These limits leave current methods ripe for reconsideration by the Courts.

Jonathan Karas' practice embraces all aspects of land law, including rights of light and planning. Before taking silk he served on the 'A' Panel of Junior Counsel to the Crown (2000–2006) and before that on the Supplementary Panel of Junior Counsel to the Crown (Common Law) (now the 'B' Panel) (1995–2000). Jonathan is a subject editor of *Hill and Redman's Law of Landlord and Tenant* and author (with David Elvin QC) of *Unlawful Interference with Land*, second edition (2002). This book sets out to test the hypothesis that the fundamental concept which determines the validity and competence of usurper regimes in common law jurisdictions is the concept of legitimacy as was clearly elucidated in the Grenada Case of Mitchell v DPP (1986). A comparative analysis of this case in juxtaposition with sixteen other extraconstitutional common law cases comprised the main scope of the study. Consequently, an exhaustive survey of these cases beginning with the Dosso case in Pakistan in 1958 and ending with the Qarase case in Fiji in 2009 was conducted. The analysis reveals that the appropriateness of utilizing any of the judicially recognized doctrinal concepts of strict constitutionalism, state necessity, Kelsen's theory of revolutionary legality and the doctrine of successful revolution depends, inter alia, on whether there was continuity or discontinuity of the legal order of the state. These doctrinal concepts have their own implications for the concept of legitimacy following the occurrence of a coup d'etat or a revolution. Legitimacy itself has important implications for resolving various extra-constitutional issues which inevitably arise.

Dr. Lawrence Albert Joseph was born in Grenada, In 1977 he became qualified as a Barrister at Law, Lincoln's Inn, London, England. On his return to Grenada, Dr. Joseph became a magistrate (1979-84), President of the Senate (1984-88) and 2013-14), Attorney General amongst other ministerial port folios (1995-2003) and Speaker of the House of Representatives (2003-08).

In the Queen's New Year Honours of 2015, Dr. Joseph was granted the award of Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of the British Empire (CBE) for his contributions to public service in Grenada. At the 2016 Independence Celebrations on 7th February in Grenada, he was awarded the Most Distinguished Order of the Nation for 2015, Knight Commander (KCN) for his contributions to Grenada. This Festschrift honours Nana Dr. Samuel Kwadwo Boaten Asante - a most distinguished legal scholar, practitioner and policymaker and a towering figure in the Ghanaian legal community. Throughout his academic and professional life, Dr. SKB Asante advanced the interests of the developing world through his scholarship, advocacy and counsel in law, development and public policy matters. Through a career that spans more than half a century of working with international organisations such as the United Nations and the World Bank, various governments around the world and academic establishments in Ghana and abroad, he worked tirelessly to introduce fresh perspectives to provide countries at the periphery of the international system with a meaningful opportunity to pursue their development aspirations. Dr. Asante is a former Solicitor-General and Deputy Attorney-General of Ghana. He was the Chairman of the Committee of Experts that drafted proposals for Ghana's current Constitution. He has published extensively including articles in the Yale Law Journal, American Journal of International Law, Review of Ghana Law and Cornell Law Journal.
